



Christoph Hintschich, MD, FEBO, graduated in Ophthalmology at the University of Munich/Germany, before he specialized in Eyelid- and Orbital Surgery. He was fellow to C. Beyer-Machule/Munich, R. Collin/London and L. Koornneef/Amsterdam. In 2002 he was appointed as a full professor of Ophthalmology at the LMU Munich. He is head of the Oculoplastic and Orbital Service, where he is involved in patient care, teaching and research. In 1993 he became full member of ESOPRS, from 2006 - 2014 he was the secretary of ESOPRS. He is Fellow of the European Board of Ophthalmology (FEBO), spokesman of SORC

He published numerous articles in peer-reviewed journals and wrote chapters on ophthalmic plastic surgical topics in renowned textbooks. His main professional interests are functional and aesthetic eyelid surgery and orbital surgery, in particular surgical rehabilitation in Graves' disease and anophthalmic socket management.
