

Willem van den Bosch was trained as an ophthalmologist in the Rotterdan Eye Hospital from 1980 to 1984. After this, he visited Richard Collin in Moorfields Eye Hospital to learn his systematic approach of eyelid surgery as well as his surgical techniques. He then started the Oculoplastic Service in The Rotterdam Eye Hospital in the Netherlands. This service gradually expanded to three oculoplastic surgeons nowadays. Over the years, Willem co-authored about fifty papers on oculoplastic subjects and presented more than 40 lectures on invitation. He presented a PhD thesis on eyelid position and apposition in 1998. He is scientific advisor of several Dutch and European research and

registration institutions. He is much honored to be offered the opportunity to present the ESOPRS Mustardé lecture in Athens.
