

## **Aesthetic and non-aesthetic bloodless periocular surgical treatment**

**Introduction:** Bloodless surgical treatment is increasingly used for the treatment of a variety of conditions involving the eyelids, instead of the established invasive treatment.

**Methods:** We describe the use of aesthetic and non-aesthetic bloodless periocular surgical technology and we present the cases before and after the treatment.

**Results:** Bloodless surgical treatment can successfully replace the surgical removal of conditions such as xanthelasma, cysts, papillomas, milia and syringomas of the eyelids. Additionally, it can substitute blepharoplasty in mild cases.

**Conclusion:** Bloodless surgical treatment can potentially be used for a variety of applications, as it offers satisfactory results without invasive techniques.
