



**Nikolaos Chalvatzis, MD, PhD**  
Assistant Professor in Ophthalmology

Dr. Nikolaos Chalvatzis graduated the Medical School of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece, in 1993. Between 1994 and 1998 he completed the obligatory national rural as well as the army medical service. He was trained in comprehensive Ophthalmology in the Ophthalmology department of AHEPA university hospital, Thessaloniki, for 4 consecutive years. In 2003 he moved to Bristol Eye Hospital, Bristol, U.K., where he undertook a fellowship in oculoplastic, orbital and squint surgery for 15 months. In 2006 he completed his PhD thesis on ultrastructural and clinical study of human corneas, which had previously undergone amniotic membrane transplantation.

In 2010 he was appointed as Lecturer in Ophthalmology in Aristotle University, with special interests in oculoplastics and orbital surgery. Since 2014 he holds the position of Assistant Professor in Ophthalmology at 2<sup>nd</sup> Department of Ophthalmology, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He authored and co-authored in more than 50 articles in international and national journals and participated in more than 150 ophthalmology congresses worldwide.
